## **ITINERARY**:

# DEFAULT PICK UP: Sealink Terminal (inside Adelaide Central Bus Station, 85 Franklin St), 06:15am

Discover the highlights of South Australia's premier nature-based tourism destination, Kangaroo Island. After an early morning pick up from your Adelaide hotel, enjoy a scenic coach journey to Cape Jervis to connect with SeaLink's 45 minute ferry crossing to Kangaroo Island (or travel by air from Adelaide to Kingscote Airport, transfers included).

Upon arrival on Kangaroo Island, enjoy the picturesque drive to Seal Bay Conservation Park. Here we walk along the beach with a National Park Ranger and get up close to a colony of rare and wild Australian Sea Lions who frolic and laze on the beach.

Head to Vivonne Bay for a delicious two-course lunch, followed by a visit to the Hanson Bay Wildlife Sanctuary, where you'll walk among eucalyptus trees looking for koalas lazing about in the trees.

Spend the afternoon at Flinders Chase National Park, renowned as a sanctuary for native Australian animals including kangaroos, wallabies, koalas and echidnas. The tour of the park will take you to the rugged southern coastline for a walk on Remarkable Rocks and Admiral's Arch. Remarkable Rocks provides great photographic opportunities and stunning sea views. Admiral's Arch boardwalk takes you down a rugged cliff face to reveal this spectacular rock archway, a natural nursery and safe haven for playful New Zealand fur seals that can be seen resting, swimming and playing in the waves or on the rocks.

On the return journey to Penneshaw or Kingscote Airport, keep your eyes peeled for more kangaroos and wallabies as we make the return journey to Adelaide. (L)

### BRING:

Sturdy walking shoes, hat and sunscreen, warm/waterproof clothing (even in summer), water bottle, camera, binoculars and motion sickness tables (for ferry).

#### **INCLUDED:**

Experienced guide, two course lunch, national park entrance fees, and return transport from Adelaide accommodation to Kangaroo Island (or upgraded flight return).
